**To start:**

Pea & gorgonzola arancini (3)

Sugar cured ocean trout, dill, horseradish cream, fried capers, dark rye

Seared scallops, romesco, fennel, apple

Chicken, pork and green olive terrine

**To follow:**

Smoked heirloom tomatoes, red onion, cashmere tart

Prawn open sandwich on rye, avocado, pickled zucchini, garden lettuce

Today's market fish, salsa verde, lemon and garlic crumb

"Steak Frites" – 180gm Black Angus porterhouse, pomme frites, café de Paris butter

**Booking details, terms and conditions**

Open for lunch 7 days per week. Bookings are essential and will be available 11.30am to 2pm. The menu is available indoors and on the deck (weather permitting). Guests will be committed to one of the fixed price menu options, this can be decided on the day. A booking is for 1 hour and 50 minutes, in line with current regulations.

Group bookings are limited to tables of 6-8 guests inside. Please book as early as possible to avoid disappointment. In the event you need to cancel or change your reservation we ask for a minimum of 24 hours notice, 48-72 hours prior is preferred.

For outdoor dining (deck), every effort has been made to cater for inclement weather should it arise, however all outdoor bookings will receive an update from us the day before, to reconfirm the forecast and make any required changes to the booking where necessary (and in the case of variable/unpredictable conditions, again on the morning of the booking itself). Market umbrellas and blankets will provide some flexibility for cooler conditions however this will be discussed with our team. Strong winds will inhibit the use of market umbrellas.
